

The Detroit Sportsmen's Congress Scholarship Fund has been established to advance deserving junior members, the children, and Grandchildren, of voting members in good standing with a minimum of two years membership in the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress to assist in achieving a quality higher education. Each student is asked to complete the application and essays. Applicants must also include two Applicant Appraisal Forms and an official high school transcript. The deadline for submission is April 1, 2010.

The Shelby Community Foundation Scholarship Committee reviews applications and will choose recipients based on criteria set by the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress Scholarship Committee. Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, creed, color, sex, or national origin.

Applications may be picked up at the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress business office at the address below. Students selected to receive scholarships will be notified by mail or telephone, and the scholarship will be awarded at the May General membership meeting of the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress.

Scholarships will be awarded on need, community involvement, and reasonable expectation that the student will succeed. The scholarships may be used at a community college, trade school or university.
