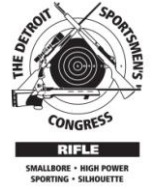




# Detroit Sportsmen's Congress Service Rifle Clinic & Match

Presented by the Education & Rifle Committees  
June 2 & 3, 2012



The purpose of this clinic is to provide instruction and training for the new junior or adult shooter in Service Rifle competition. Emphasis placed on positions, rules, competition and match operations. Clinic is open to any US citizen 14 years or older with a maximum number of 40 students. Instruction provided by certified NRA rifle instructors, who are also competitive rifle shooters.

Entry fees include all class material, match, ammunition fees and the use of a rifle. Due to range capacity and course materials, we require a non-refundable registration fee of \$40 for this clinic and match.

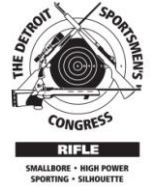
Deposits must be received before 25 May 2012, entries received after this date will be placed on stand-by. Confirmations, by email unless you include a self addressed post card with your entry.

- CLINIC:** **SATURDAY 2 June 2012** ( 9:00 am – 5:00 pm approx.) (Clubhouse)  
Indoor classroom with a hands-on practical exercises (using Garands and AR-15's)  
Lunch break taken with lunch available in the clubhouse.
- MATCH:** **SUNDAY 3 June 2012** ( 8:30 am - end) (Rifle Range) 50-round approved NRA Match.  
**MATCH IS OPEN ONLY TO THOSE STUDENTS ATTENDING THIS CLINIC**  
No lunch break taken.
- FEE:** Non-member \$90, DSC member \$60 and junior 14-18 \$30  
Fee includes clinic and match.
- ENTRIES:** Match is open only to clinic attendees. No range walk-on entries allowed.
- MATCH TIME:** Competitors must attend a mandatory squadding and safety meeting at 8:30 am.  
First relay called to the line at 8:50am with the first shot at 9:00 am.
- RIFLES:** Rifles provided, M1 Garands and AR-15 for juniors and women. Ammo provided for the Garands and juniors. Students with an AR-15 or M1 Garand rifle may use them in the match provided they pass a safety inspection.
- MATCH RULES:** Current "NRA high power rifle" rules. NRA rule 9.12, in effect (no refires allowed).  
Competitors are required to score targets. Targets scoring will be on the frame.  
Eye and ear protection required for competitors and spectators on the line (available).

- COURSE OF FIRE:** Fifty rounds plus sighters at 200-yards.  
Sighting shots allowed prior to phase 1 of each relay.  
(5-shots ~ 10-minutes ~ any position)
- Phase 1:** Slow fire standing position ~ 10-shots ~ 10-minutes  
(SR - 200 yd target)
- Phase 2:** Rapid fire standing to sitting position ~ 10-shots ~ 60-seconds  
(SR - 200 yd target)
- Phase 3:** Rapid fire standing to prone position ~ 10-shots ~ 70-seconds  
(SR-42 — 300 yd reduced target)
- Phase 4:** Slow fire prone position ~ 20-shots ~ 20-minutes  
(MR-52 — 600 yd reduced target)
- Notes:** Three-minute preparation periods provided for the rapid-fire phases.  
For slow fire, any block times will be at the discretion of the chief range officer.
