



## 2011 DSC Club Skeet Championship

On November 6th, 2011 the DSC hosted its second annual Club Skeet Championship. With the weather cooperating better than most could have expected 16 participants took to the field to see who could claim the title for 2011. Prizes were awarded for 1st and 2nd in the Main Bracket and 1st in the Losers Bracket.

In the first round the scores in the East Bracket were: Bill Saylor 21 - Jim Parsons 20, Bill DiLaura 15 - Emil Silarski 14, Rich Curlett 25 - Randy Kaszeta 22 and Andrew Bielman (2010 Champ) 24 - Paul Stafford Jr. 22. The scores for the West Bracket were: Fred Elias 22 - Preston Benfield 22 (Fred wins shoot-off), Frank Pantalena 23 - Garrett Curlett 21, Rick Trawinski 25 - Paul Stafford III 22 and Pete Pantalena 23 - Jeff Black 23 (Pete wins shoot-off)

From here the tournament takes on an added dimension as the first round losers go into a losers bracket tournament that runs along with the main bracket tourney. In the East Main bracket Bill Saylor (22) def Bill DiLaura (14), Rich Curlett (22) def Andrew Bielman (22) in a shoot-off. In the West Main bracket Rick Trawinski (24) def Pete Pantalena (22) and Frank Pantalena (24) def Fred Elias (20). The losers bracket results were Randy Kaszeta (23) def Paul Stafford Jr. (23) with Randy victorious in a shoot-off, Jim Parsons (24) def Emil Silarski (13), Jeff Black (24) def Paul Stafford III and Preston Benfield (23) def Garrett Curlett (15).

Now we started getting down to the nitty gritty. In the Semi-Finals from the East, Rich Curlett (24) def Bill Saylor (22). In the Semi's from the West, Rick Trawinski (25) def Frank Pantalena (23). Moving on the Losers Bracket Jim Parsons (23) def Randy Kaszeta (23) in a shoot-off and Jeff Black (23) def Preston Benfield (21).

Finally we come to the "FINALS". In the Main Bracket it was Rich (The Legend) Curlett going up against Rick (The Used to Be Legend) Trawinski. The Losers Bracket (and I hate calling it that because no one is a loser) had Jim (The Rifle) Parsons going against Jeff (the Young Whipper Snapper) Black. The 4 combatants met on Field 1 for the showdown at High Noon (well actually about 1:30) to determine the DSC bragging rights. In the match between Jim and Jeff both shooters scored 24's and took doubles at 3-4-5 to settle the match with Jim emerging victorious (Jeff you need to practice your doubles). In the final of main bracket two former "All American Skeet Team" members took to the field. After the 2 registered squad mates battled their way around the field and all the lead, powder and wads were shot out of their guns one man emerged the victor. Rick T defeated Rich C by the score of 25- 24.

The club wishes to thank all the participants for coming out and making this a fun event again this year. Lots of thanks go out to Frank and all the volunteers that helped in any small way. Hopefully we will see more participants next year and in new events that are in the works at the DSC.

Guns required for wild bunch is a 1911 pistol in 45 ACP, an 1897 pump shotgun and a lever action rifle over 40 caliber. Once you have the guns then all you need is a holster, magazine pouches and at least 6 magazines, then the fun begins. This month you would have been trying to out shoot Coyote Claxton, Nine Finger Bob and Camptown for first place.

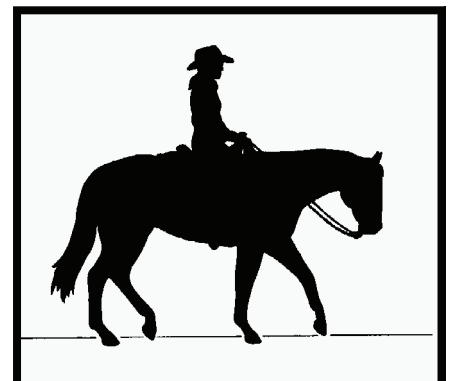
The next match was a cowboy silhouette match. We use 22 rim fire rifles or pistol caliber center fire rifles and if you think you're a real marksman you can try a handgun. The marksmen that every one was trying to catch were Bob Brossia, Mike Owczarzak and Jim Estes.

Our regular cowboy match was next. Thirty eight cowboys from Michigan, Ohio and Canada enjoyed a day of shooting, in the end J.J. Longley and Camptown were the top DSC shooters. To shoot a cowboy match you will need two single action handguns, a pistol caliber rifle and a shotgun. All guns must have been manufactured before 1900 or reproductions of original guns.

And finally the last match required a bolt action military rifle fired offhand at forty yards. Forty shots were fired at an assortment of targets consisting of water bottles, swinging targets and a tie breaker deck of cards. Two shooters tied for first with 37 hits. The high tie breaker card went to Brian Page with Jim Estes coming in second.

The last match for 2011 is a cowboy match on December 18<sup>th</sup>. Fight the urge to stay home on a cold December day and come to the last cowboy match of the year.

The 2012 cowboy season will start in March. There will be two matches, the regular cowboy match and something new. A twilight match will start ½ hour before sunset and continue into darkness. The iron sights should be difficult to see. Cowboys didn't have it any easier while riding night hawk during the cattle drive. Watch the P&K for dates and times.

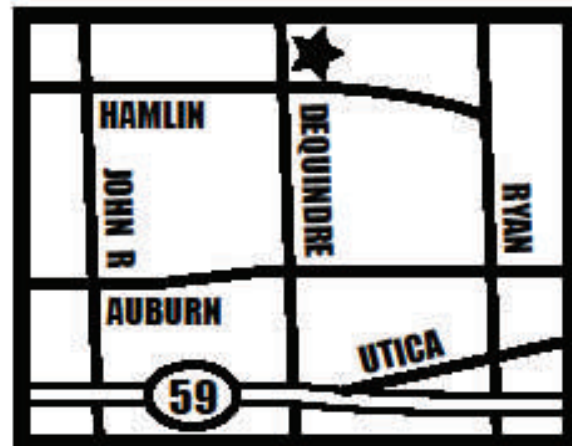

## **POLICE PISTOL COMBAT (PPC) Shooters,**

We will again have a Winter **PPC League** at the **Detroit Sportsmen's Congress in 2012** on Wednesday nights from 6:30 pm. to approx. 9:00 pm. All shooting will be done on our Indoor Range located in the basement of the Shotgun Building on Dequindre Rd. just North of Hamlin Rd. If you have never shot PPC, come on down and check it out!

**The League dates will be as follows:**

**April 4, 11**

**PPC League Course of fire:** Match 5 of the NRA course at 50 ft., using reduced B-27 targets. This is a 60 round course of fire. NRA rules allow .32 caliber or larger in a revolver and .35 caliber or larger in a pistol. Many shooters use a six shot revolver firing .38 Specials while others use 9mm, .40, or .45 caliber semi-autos. A minimum of 4 speed-loaders or magazines are required. The shooting positions used in PPC are: standing unsupported, standing with barricade support using first the left then right hand, kneeling, sitting, and prone.

**NO MAGNUM OR HIGH SPEED AMMUNITION ALLOWED. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION IS MANDATORY. SAFETY RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

We will shoot a total of Twelve (12) scores, with final League standings based on the best 10 of the 12 scores. Cash awards will be given following the end of the season and will be based on any points accumulated throughout the season. We use the Lewis system to award points, so shooters of all skill levels have a chance to earn points.

**League fees will be \$30.00.** Half of your league fees must be turned in prior to your **second (2nd) score** with the balance prior to you shooting your **fourth (4th) score**.

**There is a Range fee payable each week of \$6.00 for all DSC League members.** One dollar of this will go to the fund to cover cost of getting the impact area cleaned. **Non-Members must obtain an Associate Membership for \$30.00**, which is good **ONLY** for the duration of the PPC League (14 weeks). The range fee of \$6.00 must then be paid each week, as do all other League members.

**Smoking of sights can be done only in an area designated by the range Officer or League Director. NO dry firing except on the firing line with the Range Officers approval.**

We need shooters to make this league a success. The only thing we ask is that you give us a hand in setting up and cleaning up whenever you can.

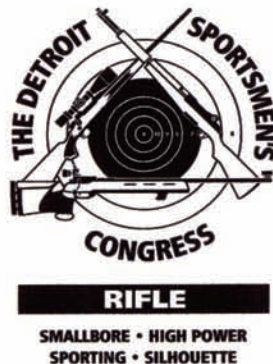
