

The Second Annual Vintage Skeet Shoot was held on May 15, here at DSC. Vintage skeet requires the use of a side-by-side or pump shotgun, starting with the down gun position and has a 0-3 second variable delay release of the target. It is an excellent simulation of hunting. It is a tough game, but we all are playing by the same rules, often having a hunter not a target shooter pull off the victory. Guns can be true vintage guns or any modern side-by-side or pump; it's the down gun and that long delay that tends to make it difficult. You likely already have a qualifying gun, so this is something many DSC members should try.
